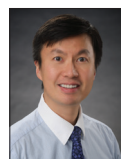
Mark Anstadt, ARNP, AAHVMS - Internal Medicine

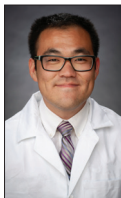
Vanessa Herring, DO - Family Medicine
